## Foreword

The purpose of this document is to clarify for parents, students and staff the application of the Uniform Policy at Hope Adventist School.
This document will show what each uniform item looks like, where it can be purchased and how it should be worn.

Our desire is to bring glory and honour to God in everything we do and we believe that wearing our uniform correctly and with respect contributes to this.

Hope students are to be in full and correct uniform when on the school grounds, travelling to and from school and at all school-organised activities unless informed otherwise by the school. This includes when wearing the uniform in public places outside of school hours.

All students, parents and staff are to be aware of this policy and support it. Our uniforms are designed to ensure our students have the best experience possible while learning and playing. Wearing their uniform correctly will impart a sense of respect, community and healthy school pride.

## Shirt



Our shirt comes in sizes 4-16 and can be purchased from the school office. Shirts are to remain untucked.

## Shorts



Our shorts are only available from Inn-Style Mensland. The name of the shorts is SCAGS 108 Gaberdine Elastic Waist School Short in black. Please make sure they are the regular length not short.

## Shoes

Students are required to wear black leather-like shoes with their uniform. They must be able to be polished. They can have laces or velcro.


## Jacket

Our school jacket can only be purchased from Inn-Style Mensland. The name of our jacket is the JB Kids Soft shell in Navy. Please ensure your jacket has the school logo on it. School jackets can be worn all year round. Please note that school jackets can take a few weeks to arrive after ordering so it is strongly encouraged to order them at the beginning of the year. Students will not be permitted to wear out of uniform jackets or jumpers. If a student has ordered a school jacket and is waiting for it to arrive they may wear a plain navy jumper in the meantime.

## Trackpants



Trackpants can be worn from
May -September. Trackpants can be purchased wherever you would like but must be black and preferrably have cuffed legs. Please pack your child's shorts in their bag as they often get too hot and need to change throughout the day.

## Hair

## Girls Hair

- It is required that girls have their collar length to long hair braided or tied up neatly with a School coloured hair tie navy, royal blue or black.
- Hair is to be well groomed and cut in a moderate style as determined by the School.
- Hair that falls over the eyes when the head is bowed forward or the student is participating in physical activity, should be tied back.


## Boys Hair

- Boy's hair should be neat and tidy at all times and haircuts should be cut in a moderate style. It should not be shorter than a \#3 cut.
- No 'flashes', razor cuts, undercuts or other severe variations in hair length are permitted.
- If hair is below the collar, it must be tied back neatly.



## Jewellery

- No jewellery, other than a watch and earrings, is permitted. Smart watches with no internet and phone access are allowed.
- Earrings are limited to plain gold or silver studs.
- No rings, necklaces, bangles or bracelets are to be worn.


## Uniform Expectations

Students are to be in full and correct uniform when on the school grounds, travelling to and from school, and at school organised activities unless informed otherwise by school staff.

If your child is out of uniform a note or Seesaw message should be sent to your child's teacher explaining the circumstances.

School staff will be looking to hand out 'shout outs' to students who are in correct uniform and who are wearing it with pride. We will however also be handing out uniform infringements where needed. Three uniform infringements equals a detention. We may ask you to replace uniforms if they do not meet quality standards (contain rips, holes, faded colours etc). 7
